



Home Learning Procedures

The following procedures will be followed where Covid-19 issues present:

1. If a child is off due to a positive test result or symptoms-no work to be sent home (as they are ill)
2. If a child is off due to waiting a test result for themselves (they have symptoms) -no work to be sent home (as they are ill)
3. If a child is off due to awaiting a test result from a family member, they are not ill and the teacher/lead will send home *Class Learning immediately until the test result is received
4. If a child is off due to being a close contact at home-the teacher/lead will send home *Class Learning for 10 days
5. If the Nursery School has a 'whole school closure', Home Learning Series work will be sent home for all pupils
6. If Nursery School is open and the full educational opportunities are available in nursery, no work will be sent home where parents are choosing to keep their child off
7. If Nursery School closes a bubble/group due to a positive case, Home Learning Series will be sent home for the 10 days
8. Teachers will keep a note/log of Home Learning sent home so that there is no duplication of Home Learning sent home
9. Teachers will make contact by phone to parents & guardians of vulnerable children to provide home learning support regardless of the reason for absence. This will be monitored by the Headteacher

Engagement and feedback

What are your expectations for my child's engagement and the support that we as parents and carers should provide at home?

□ Parents are expected to support their child's engagement with home

learning at home

- You can support your child by setting routines and ensuring they have a good bedtime routine to ensure they are ready for learning the next day
- To provide Nursery School with feedback regarding Home Learning. This may be photographs or short written comment by email

How will you check whether my child is engaging with their work and how will I be informed if there are concerns?

Soneygate Nursery School will:

- contact parents by email or phone to check pupils' engagement with home education and if there are any concerns, the teacher will discuss how the child can be supported by nursery
- contact parents where there has been no contact/feedback made
- support parents in providing the relevant resources needed for Home Learning to help children continue with their learning

How will you assess my child's work and progress?

Feedback can take many forms and may not always mean extensive written comments for individual children. Our approach to feeding back on Home Learning is as follows:

- email or phone call to parents by class teacher

Additional support for pupils with particular needs

How will you work with me to help my child who needs additional support from adults at home to access home education?

We recognise that some pupils, for example; some pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), may not be able to access home education without support from adults at home. We acknowledge the difficulties this may place on families, and we will work with parents and

carers to support those pupils in the following ways:

- Mrs Peachey (SENCo) will contact parents and discuss strategies to support parents delivering home education for pupils with SEND that are based on the child's individual needs

*Class learning to be sent home will relate to the teaching and learning taking place in the nursery school at that time and should be proportionate to the time of absence. Consideration must be given as the child may develop symptoms or become ill.

Parents may contact Nursery School at any time to discuss Home Learning and Home Learning. Please contact us if you require any support to deliver Home Learning.
